BRIAN C. JOHNSON NAMED AS NEW EI CEO

Equality Illinois' work on behalf of LGBT Illinoisans and their families enters its second quarter century under a new leader who has a history of social justice advocacy, building diverse coalitions and improving educational outcomes for youth.

Named as the Chief Executive Officer of Equality Illinois is Brian C. Johnson, who currently serves as a Vice President at Leadership for Educational Equity, a national organization that works to get teachers and former teachers more politically and civically active.

Johnson, a former public school teacher, has spent more than a decade leading high profile advocacy campaigns, including those

centered on social justice and youth issues.

CITIZEN ADVOCATES MEET WITH GOVERNOR AND LEGISLATORS TO SUPPORT TRANSGENDER ILLINOISANS

Advocates at Equality Illinois' 2016 LGBT Advocacy Day–including a transgender university student and the mother of a transgender child–met with Gov. Bruce Rauner and legislators in Springfield last month to advance a pro-LGBT equality agenda during the spring session of the General Assembly.

In a meeting in the Governor's Office arranged by Equality Illinois, the advocates urged the governor to support a bill to modernize birth certificate changes for transgender Illinoisans (HB 6073), to oppose a second measure that would stigmatize and discriminate against transgender students (HB 4474) and to adopt a responsible budget that protects vital services for Illinoisans.
