The Equality Illinois (EI) Community Advisory Group helps inform and develop the public policy agenda that advances full equality and inclusion for LGBTQ individuals and families. The Group brings together an inclusive cross-section of LGBTQ voices from across Illinois.

Objectives of the Community Advisory Group:

- Engage grassroots LGBTQ individuals and allies in the policy work and agenda building to advance LGBTQ equality and social justice in Illinois
- Ensure the LGBTQ policy agenda is crafted with input from an inclusive coalition of stakeholders from across Illinois
- Offer professional development and leadership training for grassroots LGBTQ individuals
- Identify individuals who can be surrogates or advocates to public officials, local media, and other organizations on LGBTQ issues

Responsibilities of Group Members:

- Participate in monthly calls to inform and give feedback on El's legislative agenda
- Participate in reactive calls, as necessary, to respond to situations facing LGBTQ Illinoisans
- Meet at least twice a year at meetings or receptions in Illinois (subject to available resources)
- Act as a surrogate to public officials, other organizations, and local media (when authorized by EI staff)

There will be opportunities for professional development (as requested by members of the Community Advisory Group and based on available resources):

- Media training
- Issue presentations
- Fundraising training

People of color, women, and transgender people are strongly encouraged to apply to be members of the Community Advisory Group.

Final decisions about El's policy agenda will be made by El staff and our Board of Directors. The Community Advisory Group will provide critical insight.
